

Logan and Gold Coast Faster Rail



Project update

September 2025

The Australian and Queensland governments are delivering the Logan and Gold Coast Faster Rail (LGC) project to unlock additional services to address the high travel demand between Brisbane and the Gold Coast.

The project will also make it easier for everyone to access train services through modern station upgrades and improved walking and cycling connections, as well as improved safety and reduced traffic congestion for local communities through level crossing removals.


What's new

The LGC project has reached an important milestone with award of the design and pre-construction contract for the major works package to the ActivUs consortium.

ActivUs, with the Department of Transport and Main Roads and Queensland Rail, will form the LGC Rail Alliance to deliver the LGC Rail package. The LGC Rail Alliance is progressing with design activities, further construction planning and additional site investigations.

The community and key stakeholders will be re-engaged to seek feedback on the design and provide an update on future project activities.

This announcement follows the September 2024 award of the Open Level Crossing Removal package to Bielby Hull Joint Venture (JV) and the related Loganlea Station Relocation (LSR) package to the Martinus Degnan JV.



Project benefits

It's not only existing rail customers using stations between Kuraby and Beenleigh who'll reap the benefits of the project. Here are just some of the changes that might benefit you.

Doubling the tracks from two to four will:

- enable more express trains to operate between Brisbane and the Gold Coast
- reduce waiting times at stations
- improve reliability of services.

Modern station upgrades with improved walking and cycling connections will make it easier for customers to access high frequency train services.

Removing five level crossings will:

- improve safety for rail and road users and the local community
- reduce traffic congestion
- improve accessibility and connectivity across the rail corridor.

Moving Loganlea station closer to the Logan Hospital will make it easier to access health and other essential services.

What's next?

Key activities we're delivering in 2025/26 include:

- community and stakeholder engagement on the updated design and communicating project progress
- the detailed design and start of early construction works for the level crossing removal at Kuraby
- site investigations and noise assessments to inform the updated design for the LGC Rail package
- establishment of the LGC Rail package Environmental Reference Group
- ongoing construction of the new Loganlea station.
